

Here are a few important notes of clarification, as well as attachments/instructions to share with your unit...

The purpose of what I showed was the "Handcial" how to and to demonstrate the 'Waterless Spa Pampering'. By no means was it a full class. Your opening, closing, ticket game, guest interaction, etc would of course still be incorporated in. And you can take these 'portions' and incorporate them into anything!!!!

**AND MOST IMPORTANT...these parties do NOT take the place of a Skin Care Class!!!!**

**They are a supplement to them.**

Sometimes you have women who aren't interested in attending a skin care class ("been there, done that") but they'll come to a spa pampering event! It's kind of like a back door to offer them the chance to fall in love with you and fall in love with Mary Kay!

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And here's the foot covers & 'how to' to share! Your unit and customers will L-O-V-E the pampering!!!!

Waterless Foot Pampering (to incorporate into any head to toe pampering spa party)

The towels come from Walmart (auto section, soft terry cloth about 18x18-they're rolled up) \$4 per dozen

I get them wet and nuked and then store in a plastic grocery bag, then put them in an insulated cooler.

They'll stay hot until I need them.

Have customer apply the satin hands (both EENC & Smoothie Scrub) to one foot, then she places her foot onto the hot wet towel & wraps it around her foot, slip the spa cover on & clip closed with a clothespin.

Repeat for other foot.

3rd towel needed to clean hands. Keep handy for after cleaning everything off feet & applying mint bliss lotion.

This way they can wipe the mint bliss off before tossing in their hand towel :)

By having the feet wrapped and bagged, the satin hands 'processes' and works even better. AND you get time to play a ticket game or demo other products & not worry about the towels cooling too fast.

**AND there's no buckets of water to slosh around!!!!!!!!!!**

Once finished, they can put their used towel bag into the bag & drop them all in a pillowcase for transport home.

This way, when they are washed you can (delegate) empty each bag into the washer without ever touching the towels themselves! :)
